The Diploma in Arts provides a pathway into the Bachelor of Arts degree. A qualification in the Arts can cover a broad range of humanities units from writing and literature to studies of other cultures, religions and languages. It can also enable you to access a pathway to Teaching and studies in Psychology, with up to one-year equivalent advanced standing. Furthermore, this course offers a foundation unit in Academic English that provides an additional skills base for tertiary level study.
